

VINI ROSSI

Sangiovese La Sagrestana (ITALY) £15

Aromas of forest fruits and medium bodied palate.

Merlot, Lanya (CHILE) £19

Red cherry and plum aromas then ripe plum, vanilla and blackberry flavours, complemented by sweet ripe tannins.

Malbec, Bodegas Santa Ana (ARGENTINA) £21

Medium bodied and dry with soft, ripe blackcurrant flavours and balancing structure, finish.

Montepulciano+ D`Abruzzo, La Borgata (ITALY) £23

Full, rounded with blackberry fruit and a hint of liquorice.

Chianti Foriero, Cecchi (ITALY) £25

Intensely aromatic with violet notes whilst the palate is well balanced and firm; the classic signature of Chianti.

Negroamaro del Salento, Varvaglione (ITALY) £28

The nose has fascinating scents of wild berries. The palate is marked by vanilla with a long lingering finish.

Pinot Noir, Reserva, Vina Leyda (CHILE) £26

Dark berry nose, a compact and densely flavoured palate of ripe forest fruit and herbal notes.

Shiraz, MAN Family (SOUTH AFRICA) £26

Distinctive aromas of ripe plum and pepper spices, mouth-filling sweet red-berry flavours.

Rioja Crianza, Vina Cerrada (SPAIN) £29

Plum aromas fuse with cinnamon, caramel with well structured palate of fruit and oak flavours tannins.

Rosso di Montepulciano, Poliziano (ITALY) £39

A young and fruity wine, full bodied but not aggressive, It displays a good balance of complexity and drinkability.

Chianti Classico Riserva Ris. di Famiglia, Cecchi (ITALY) £49

Mature, dark fruit, spices and a slight smoky finish, it is concentrated and elegant with supple tannins.

Amarone Valpolicella Classico DOC Villa Borghetti £67

Deep dark ruby with notes of black and sour cherries, berries, spices and dried fruit. The palate is creamy with soft tannins and integrated oak.

Barolo di Serralunga d'Alba DOCG, Fontanafredda £65

Intense vanilla, spice, and rosebush aromas. Full Bodied but soft, velvety and well balanced.
